## APRIL 18, 2021 - 3<sup>RD</sup> SUNDAY OF EASTER

Based on the recent provincial announcement to implement further measures against the third wave of the COVID 19 pandemic, effective Monday, April 19, 2021:

- Sunday Masses at 9 am in English & 11 am in Italian will continue to be livestreamed and can be watched on our YouTube channel.
  - Our Parish will remain open for private prayers with a maximum restriction of 10 people at a time.
    - Confessions will be by appointment only.
  - Weddings, Funerals and Baptisms are restricted to 10 persons including those who will be involved in the ministry (priest, cantor, etc.).
  - Celebrations of the Sacraments of First Holy Communion and Confirmation will be temporarily postponed until further notice. Online course classes continue as scheduled.
