Kristen is a college student whose mother recently died. The sense of loss led to crippling anxiety, which made it hard for her to eat, sleep or study. She decided to attend a free walk-in counselling clinic offered by Catholic Family Services of Simcoe County, a ShareLife-funded agency. She found the session helpful, so she agreed to attend several more. With her clinician's help, Kristen learned what triggered her panic attacks and developed a plan to battle her anxiety.
