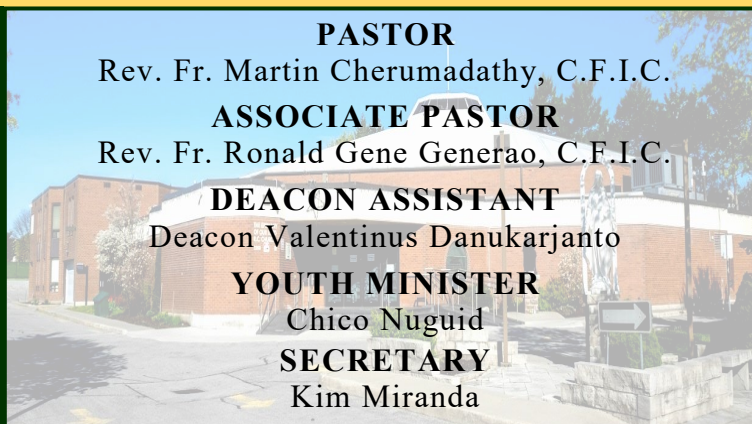

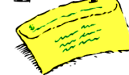
FEAST OF STO. NIÑO (HOLY CHILD)

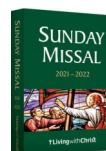
