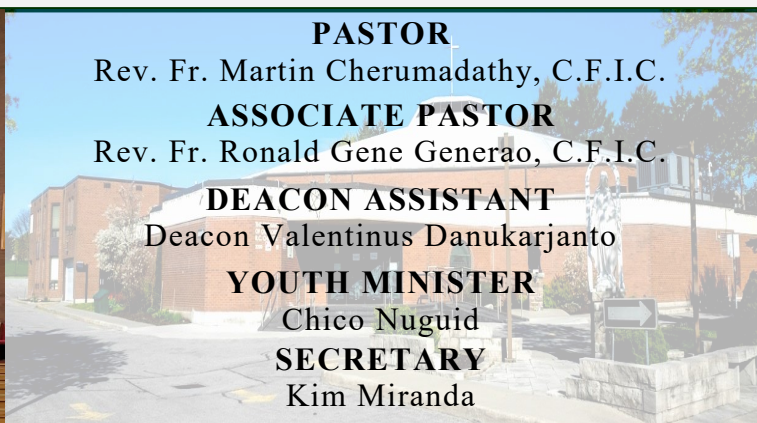

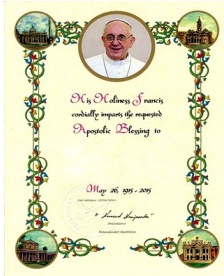
VOCATION SEED

PAPAL BLESSINGS



Parishioners may order a Papal Blessing scroll to commemorate a milestone wedding anniversary or birthday, as well as the reception of the sacrament of baptism, first communion, confirmation, marriage, and religious ordination and profession. As of 2015, all orders are processed directly through the Office of Papal Charities at the Vatican. To obtain a Papal Blessing, a request form must be filled out and faxed or mailed to the Parchment Office in Vatican City. Request forms and additional information can be found on the [Office of Papal Charities website](#). *Please note under the rules of the Vatican, a Papal Blessing cannot be issued to an institution, organization, group or association etc. or for non-practicing Catholics.

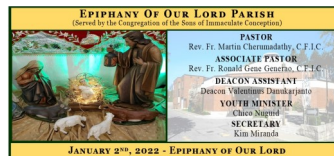
