Effective July 16, 2021, the provincial government has implemented the move towards the Step 3 of the Roadmap for Reopening plan. Based on this new mandate, the new guidelines from the Archdiocese of Toronto for all Catholic Churches are as follows:

- For Sacramental celebrations, there is no capacity limit for places of worship. However, physical distancing of 2 meters (6 ft.) is still required between parishioners attending Mass who are not from the same household. Due to the physical distancing requirements, parishes with the technology to livestream Mass at the hall can accommodate an increased capacity.
- For Funerals, the Bereavement Authority of Ontario is no longer implementing a maximum capacity restriction for funerals. Similar to other sacramental celebrations, there are no capacity restrictions for funerals as long as 2 meters of physical distancing can be maintained.
- Meetings or other indoor spaces are permitted provided that attendance do not exceed 50% of the meeting space capacity. Participants must wear face masks and the 2-meter physical distancing is maintained between those not from the same household. Sign-in sheet for meetings will be provided for contact tracing purposes. Meals or food service at meetings is discouraged at this time.
- Livestreaming of services should continue where this practice is underway and the dispensation from the Sunday Eucharist continues. The elderly, those with compromised immune systems or other health conditions should be encouraged to exercise extreme caution about any outings, including attendance at church. Virtual meetings may still replace in-person meetings where appropriate.

Please note that in Step 3, local municipal by-laws remain in place -

Mask use indoors should continue at this time even for those who are fully vaccinated.

A partire dal 16 luglio 2021, il Governo Provinciale ha implementato il passaggio alla terza fase del piano governativo per la riapertura. Sulla base di questo nuovo mandato, le nuove linee guida dell'Arcidiocesi di Toronto per tutte le Chiese cattoliche, sono le seguenti:

1. Per le celebrazioni Sacramentali nei luoghi di culto, non sono previsti limiti di capienza , tuttavia è ancora richiesta la distanza fisica di 2 metri (6 piedi) tra i parrocchiani che partecipano alla Messa : sono esclusi i fedeli che appartengono allo stesso nucleo familiare. A causa dell'obbligo del distanziamento fisico, le parrocchie che trasmettono la messa life streaming su YouTube, possono accomodare nella sala parrocchiale i fedeli che non trovano posto in chiesa.
2. Per i funerali e altre celebrazioni Sacramentali, le Autorita` Governative dell' Ontario , hanno messo a bando la restrizione di capacità massima, purché si rispetti la distanza fisica di 2 metri.
3. Sono consentiti raduni all' interno, purché i partecipanti non superano il 50% della capienza dello spazio congressuale. I partecipanti devono indossare le mascherine e mantenere la distanza fisica di 2 metri tra di loro , esclusi quelli che appartengono allo stesso nucleo familiare. Ad ogni congresso , verrà fornito un foglio di accesso da compilare per il contatto. Durante le riunioni , per adesso , sono sconsigliati pasti e servizio di ristorazione.
4. La diretta streaming puo` continuare dove è in corso questa pratica, così pure la distribuzione dell'Eucaristia domenicale. Gli anziani con sistema immunitario compromesso, o con altri problemi di salute, dovrebbero prestare estrema attenzione in qualsiasi attività, inclusa la presenza in chiesa. Le riunioni virtuali , possono comunque sostituire le riunioni di presenza , dove e` appropriato.

Si prega di notare che nel passaggio alla terza fase , le leggi comunali locali, rimangono in vigore: l'uso della mascherina all'interno di qualsiasi locale pubblico anche per coloro che sono completamente vaccinati.

WORLD DAY FOR GRANDPARENTS & THE ELDERLY



Pope Francis has decided to institute the Church-wide celebration of World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly. Starting this year, to be held on the fourth Sunday of July (July 25), close to the liturgical memorial of Saints Joachim and Anne, the grandparents of Jesus.

Cardinal Farrell, Prefect of the Dicastery for Laity, Family and Life, pointed out that “this is the first fruits of the Amoris Laetitia Family Year, a gift to the whole Church that is destined to continue into the future. The pastoral care of the elderly is a priority that can no longer be postponed by any Christian community. In the encyclical Fratelli Tutti, the Holy Father reminds us that no one is saved alone. With this in mind, we must treasure the spiritual and human wealth that has been handed down from generation to generation”.
