The impact of the COVID-19 pandemic is continuously shifting and changing, yet we are hopeful that this summer, we may begin to return and reconnect with the meaningful things in our lives that take place in person. A concern that many have shared is how to restore life to our parish and faith communities. We have been separated for so long, and many of our fellow Catholics may question whether attending Mass or returning to our regular parish activities is still important for them. Indeed, we must undertake much discernment and discussion as a Church community to accompany and support our families, friends, and communities to navigate these uncertain times. Again, we turn to the gospel message that clearly outlines what the shepherds and disciples are to do: go out into the wilderness to reach them, to gather and love the lost. In the midst of his own exhaustion and need to rest, Jesus “had compassion for them.” We need to do likewise.
