Effective June 30, 2021, the Archdiocese’s directive based on the recent provincial announcement for all places of worship under the Step 2 of the Reopening Plan are as follows:

- For sacramental celebrations, churches are permitted 25 per cent capacity (Mass, Baptisms, Weddings, First Communion, Confirmations).
- Parishes are now permitted to utilize 25 per cent capacity inside the church and 25 per cent capacity of the parish hall for overflow where applicable. Overflow in the hall should be used for Saturday vigil or Sunday Masses only.
- The faithful should be reminded not to congregate in large numbers in or around the church before or after services. Particular attention should be directed to weddings, funerals and baptisms.
- Livestreaming of services should continue where this practice is underway and the dispensation from the Sunday Eucharist continues. The elderly, those with compromised immune systems or other health conditions should be encouraged to exercise extreme caution about any outings, including attendance at church.
- Please continue to take great care in implementing robust health and safety measures in the rectory and office. In addition to keeping our parishioners safe, every measure should be taken to protect our clergy, essential staff and any volunteers who are required to assist at this time.
- The Parish office is also temporarily closed until further notice. For any assistance or inquiries, please email or call the office and leave your name and contact information.

Dear friends, It's been said that the opposite of addiction is not sobriety, but human connection.

What, then, has this meant for people with addictions during COVID? St. Michael's Homes, an agency funded by your gift to ShareLife, has seen firsthand how the stress and isolation of the pandemic has affected the men with addictions they serve. Many individuals were already experiencing unemployment, food and housing insecurities, and other mental illnesses.

The agency understood that adapting their recovery groups to connect clients virtually was a life-or-death initiative: in the first six months of the pandemic, 1,237 people died of opioid-related causes in Ontario, compared to 766 in the six months prior. St. Michael's Homes also maintains a list of isolated clients they check in on weekly by phone or video. One of these men, Aaron, was crying as he picked up the phone. He said he was so lonely and the weekly call was the one thing he looked forward to. After receiving comfort and reassurance, Aaron was able to calm down and talk about the positive things in his life. A simple 10 minute call was all it took to let him know he was not alone and that he had a community that cared about him.
