**FOOD DONATION DRIVE, JUNE 15 TO 30**

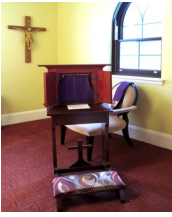

**Sacramento Della Riconciliazione  
Per Adulti Come Confessarsi**

1. Prima di accostarsi alla Confessione si deve fare un esame di coscienza (vedere retro) e riflettere sui propri peccati.

2. Si dà inizio alla Confessione dicendo, “Nel nome del Padre e del Figlio e dello Spirito Santo. Benedicimi, Padre, perché ho peccato. L’ultima volta che mi sono confessato è stato (...indicare il periodo di tempo trascorso). Questi sono i miei peccati...” Quando si confessa i propri peccati: • Identificare il peccato specifico, evitando però di scendere in dettagli ed in altre informazioni superflue. • Se non si è certi di ciò che può essere peccato, chiedere al sacerdote. • Normalmente, se non si chiede specificatamente una guida, il sacerdote si limiterà ad un breve consiglio.

3. Una volta conclusa la Confessione, il sacerdote indicherà azioni da compiere o preghiere da recitare (ovvero la Penitenza), come risposta alla misericordia di Dio.

4. Il sacerdote chiederà poi al penitente di manifestare la propria contrizione recitando a voce alta l’Atto di Dolore (vedere testo in fondo).

5. Il sacerdote quindi stenderà la mano destra verso il penitente e reciterà la Preghiera d’Assoluzione; Il penitente risponderà “Amen.”

6. Il sacerdote dirà qualcosa come: “Il Signore ha perdonato i tuoi peccati. Va in pace.” Il penitente può rispondere, “Rendo grazie a Dio.” ATTO DI DOLORE Mio Dio, mi pento e mi dolgo con tutto il cuore dei miei peccati, perché peccando ho meritato i tuoi castighi, e molto più perché ho offeso Te, infinitamente buono e degno di essere amato sopra ogni cosa. Propongo col tuo santo aiuto di non offenderti mai più e di fuggire le occasioni prossime di peccato. Signore, misericordia, perdonami.
