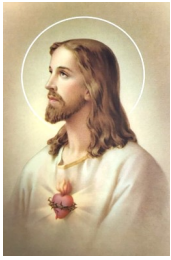

Vocation Seed



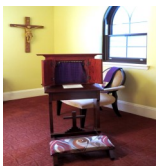
