**Notes:**

- Receipts for the **Building & Maintenance Fund and Social/Fundraising/Parish Groups** were higher in 2024 than 2025, driven by special collections for the Sanctuary Renovation project and the Golden Jubilee celebrations.
- The **Special Diocesan Collections** include the parish-based contributions and Pre-Authorized Giving (PAG). This total does not include securities and on-line donations made directly through the Archdiocese.
- The **Supplemental Information** table to the right outlines the details of investments held with the Archdiocese.
- Clergy Salaries & Stipends** - As members of the Congregation of the Sons of Immaculate Conception under a vow of poverty, chastity, and obedience, the Pastor and Associate Pastor receive no personal remuneration. All salaries and stipends are remitted directly to their religious order.
- Lay/Musician Salaries** - Salaries are paid to full-time employees, part-time employees, student staff and rectory staff. Volunteer musicians receive no remuneration.

**Notes (Continued):**

- Payroll Remittances** include mandatory government deductions (CPP, EI) and employer contributions for employee benefits, specifically the Archdiocesan pension plan, health and dental coverage.
- Repairs & Maintenance** costs rose in 2025 due to front lobby water damage repairs, the replacement of the main roof skylight and chapel/hallway flooring.
- Property Additions/Restorations** - In 2024, the Sanctuary Renovation project costs totaled \$210,155.49 (net of HST Rebate recovery).

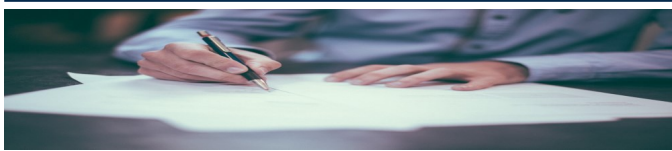
## SENIORS' GROUP'S MEETING, WEDNESDAY, MAY 13, 10:30 A.M.

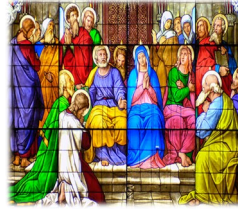

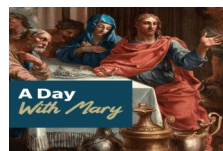
