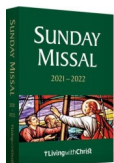
It is spiritually valuable to participate in Mass at any time, but to do so on consecutive First Fridays is a custom associated with devotion to the Sacred Heart.

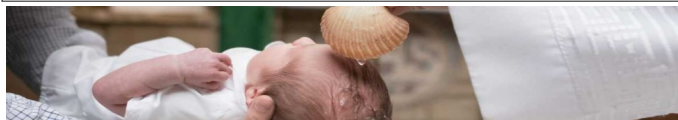

REQUIREMENTS

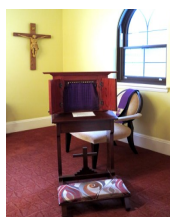
1. Child's Baptism Certificate
