Approximate social start time: 8:00 p.m.

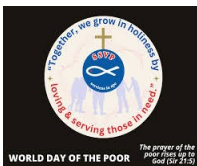

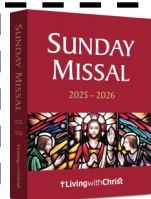
