UNDERSTANDING ADVENT CANDLES



Advent Candles represent Jesus' coming as a light in the darkness. One candle is lit each Sunday until all four candles are lit. As Christmas draws near, each candle brings a little more light into the darkness. A **White Candle** will be lighted on Christmas Eve or Christmas Day to symbolize that Jesus is with us. This is referred to as the "**Christ Candle**".

1st Candle (Purple): The Prophecy Candle, representing hope and the anticipation of Christ's coming.

2nd Candle (Purple): The Bethlehem Candle, representing peace and preparation.

3rd Candle (Pink): The Shepherd's Candle, representing joy at the birth of Christ and the anticipation of His return.

4th Candle (Purple): The Angel's Candle, representing love.

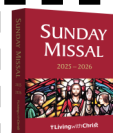

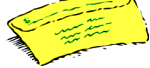
MARRIAGE PREPARATION COURSE
