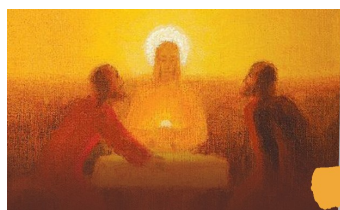

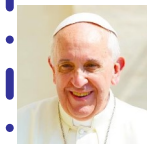

Today's Gospel with the blind man Bartimaeus shows us that we don't really need to have our "act together" before we begin to pray.
