A) For First Communion: Grade 2 students & up as of September 2026 / **B)** For Confirmation: Grade 7 students & up as of September 2026 / **C)** Original & Photocopy of the candidate's Baptism Certificate at the time of registration / **D)** \$50.00 First Communion Registration Fee and \$75.00 Confirmation Registration Fee to cover the costs of class materials, retreat, gown, & other expenses / **E)** Commitment to attend Mass regularly at our Parish and the mandatory preparation classes.

No Registration will be accepted without these requirements. Confirmation sponsors will be required to submit a copy of their Confirmation Certificates.

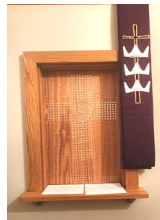
