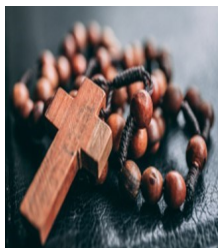

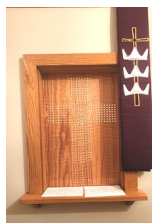

- 3) Original & Photocopy of the candidate's Baptism Certificate;
- 4) \$50.00 Registration Fee to cover the costs of class materials, retreat, gowns, & other expenses throughout the year;
- 5) Commitment to attend Mass regularly at our Parish and the mandatory preparation classes

Confirmation sponsors will be required to submit a copy of their Confirmation Certificates.
